Leonard began his career at a young age in the agriculture industry by growing potatoes for McCain Foods. He continued to build on his success by uniting other agricultural producers to develop water irrigation reservoirs in Southern Manitoba. This inspired the confidence of McCain to build their world-class processing plant in Portage La Prairie in the late 1990s.

The secret to his success was learning how to manage stress and risk. Leonard overcame near bankruptcy twice!

At this event, Leonard will be speaking about how these two events nearly destroyed his career, but how his faith played an instrumental role in dealing with stress and risk. In these times of economic uncertainty, you may find yourself in a situation beyond your control. You'll find Leonard's story encouraging and inspiring as he shares how a spiritual component in life could also help you through a difficult time.

Leonard is currently the president of Power to Change. He lives with his wife of 26 years, Debbie, and 4 children in Abbotsford, BC.
